The following lists have been developed for CRA member comment

### **Re Macro Municipal issues :**

Disregard for electoral reform in local government

- Disregard for Transport congestion
- Loss of Planning control
- Non-support for heritage issues
- Push for density without essential infrastructure investment
- Ignoring state government's own social housing policies, promoting intentional exclusion rather than social inclusion (promised salt & pepper public/private housing mix reversed to segregated, 'gated' private houses.
- sale of public land for private profit

### **Re Carlton specific issues issues :**

- Make infrastructure investment - KSC / Library / childcare/ Pre-school
- Address social housing – deliver salt and pepper mix – not segregated public private housing
- Address Transport / traffic/ roads issues eg. – disregard Eddington, curb ViCRoads, induce ViCRoads to cooperate in re-designing Elgin / Lygon St. intersection. Re-design tram stop at Faraday and Swanston.
- Sustain Gardens-/ Streets – further greening, fund water harvesting
- Stop sale of public land for private profit developments
- Stop blatant reduction in public open space
