The Carlton Residents Association advocates on behalf of its members to preserve heritage values and amenity in Carlton by the preservation maintenance of existing buildings, streetscapes and sympathetic development.

In this instance the following objections are made:

- A The proposal, due to its bulk fails to respect the character, form, massing and scale of buildings within the Heritage Overlays located near the site and is contrary to Clauses referring to Cultural Identity and Neighbourhood Character of the area.
- C We suggest that, considering the overall façade treatment fronting Drummond St and Moton Place, a greater degree of articulation and fragmentation of the basic rectilinear form of the proposed building could be introduced (perhaps with further setbacks at the upper levels) to facilitate a more harmonious dialogue with the existing streetscape fabric.
